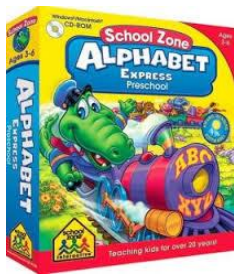


Technology Education

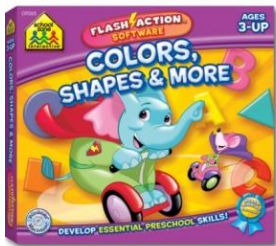
