



YOUTH CATECHESIS COVID-19 PLAN

In preparation for in-person catechesis for the 2020-2021 year, we are establishing the following safety protocols in response to the COVID-19 situation. We will adjust plans as necessary to follow the recommendations of local and state health officials and local school districts.

- All in-person catechesis will register at 50% capacity, with social distancing measures in place as best as possible given our classroom, youth center, and atrium set-ups.
- Those in the building will be required to wear face masks while they are here. Parents must wear masks when dropping off and picking up their students. Students and catechists will wear masks in their classroom, the youth center, or atrium.
- Volunteers and children will sanitize (or thoroughly wash) their hands as they enter their classroom, the youth center, or atrium, and after sneezing or coughing.
- Snacks and water will not be provided; however, parents may send those items to class with their child as needed.
- Extra cleaning and disinfecting protocols will be instituted on a daily basis between and during classes to reduce exposure and spread of disease.
- If a shelter-in-place order is placed on our area at some point in the year, alternative, remote instruction options will be offered until the order is lifted and in-person classes can resume.
- Homeschool / Online Catechesis will also be available.
